Galvanized steel frame	\$230	The upfront cost returns many times.
Chassis made with galvanized, steel-tube frame and torsion axles.	\$1515	The frame will stand up to all challenges; no annual spring hanger maintenance.
14" aluminum wheels vs 12" steel wheels	\$246	Vehicle is safer and experiences 46% less wear than 12" tires.
Aluminum skin on the bottom.	\$261	Cabin protection will last a generation and can be repaired.
